Fresno Chamber PAC Advances Five Figure Campaign Effort in Support of City Planner Annalisa Perea

Fresno, CA (May 18, 2022) FRESNO, CALIFORNIA – The Fresno Chamber Political Action Committee (PAC) recently launched a five-figure independent spending effort in support of Fresno City Council District 1 candidate Annalisa Perea.
